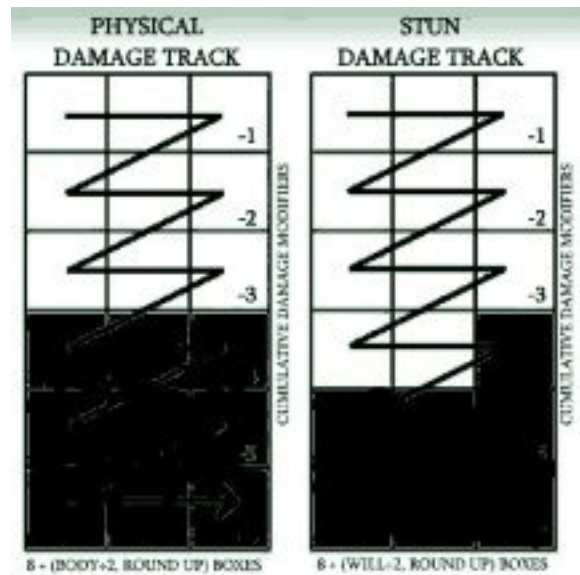
Qualities (-20 BP)

Magician (+15 BP) Starts with a Magic Attribute of 1. Shamanic tradition.

Combat Paralysis (-20 BP) For first initiative test in combat, only roll half of attribute. -3 die pool modifier to surprise tests. Sometimes +1 threshold modifier to composure tests in combat situations.

Gremlins (-10 BP) When using a piece of tech, glitches occur if ((half the dice)-2), but at least one of the dice, comes up 1.

SINner (-5 BP) The character has a legal identity, and is in regular databases.

Spells (9 BP)

Stunbolt

Category: Combat Type: Mana Range: LOS Duration: I Damage: S Drain Value: (F/2)-1

Stunbolt channels magical energy directly into a single target, causing stun damage.

Analyze Truth

Category: Detection Type: Mana Range: T Duration: S Drain Value: (F/2)-1

The spell needs at least one net success to function, the caster must hear the statements with the target in range, and the spell does not work on written materials or through any technological medium. Half-truths, or things that the target believes to be true, are detected as truth by this spell.

Mob Mood

Category: Manipulation Type: Mana Range: LOS(A) Duration: S Drain Value: (F/2)+2

The targets feel an overwhelming emotion, chosen by the spellcaster. The targets believe in the emotion wholeheartedly, but not mindlessly. Targets who try to take actions that are not relevant to the emotion, suffer a -2 die pool modifier for the action. The caster may switch emotions with a simple action.

Background:

Since being 'discovered' and working in several films, sims, and television programs, Kitty has grown quickly used to the luxury lifestyle.

Jered and Rebecca encouraged Kivi in her dream of stardom. For one thing, they really didn't think that she was bright enough for anything else (unlike her younger sister, Hannah). The fact that she manifested UGE as an elf seemed to be an advantage in the entertainment industry. And finally, the shamanic powers that Kivi manifested (in particular "Mob Mood") seemed to be just the thing needed to give an aspiring actress an extra edge. Besides, she could always find a nice man to settle down with and take care of her.

Recently Kitty has begun honing her craft. In particular, she is studying something called "the method." Which seems to be an exercise in declaring out loud that you understand and are one with a character, occasionally distracting yourself from the script to think instead on points of your own childhood, and treating each line on stage as if it is in isolation and unrelated to the other things happening on stage. Kitty doesn't really understand it, but of course she can't say that if she's a serious actress.

Kitty * is especially interested in whatever cause du jour is making the TV and talk-show circuit, and tries to attend any awareness-raising fundraisers and benefits she can for those causes.
